The Department for School Education and Sport, Maharashtra announced the second list of merits today, on December 5, 2020 at 5pm on their official website. Students who have applied for admission to class 11 can check their selection status online. Students can visit the site - mumbai.11thadmission.org.in or scroll down to get the direct connection for students' convenience. Confirm Admission by December 9, 2020 All students must confirm their admission by paying the required application fees soon. Junior College has been instructed to complete the admissions process for students who are selected in the second round by December 9, as well as to place the status of accepted students on the website by 8am. Students whose name did not appear on the list have another chance to gain recognition. In addition, colleges are allowed to start classes after 75% of the places are occupied. First year Junior College (FYJC) is the 11th admission procedure conducted by maharashtra board for admission of students in the 11th, i.e. 1th year of junior college. Online registrations start from July 26, 2020. FYJC 2020 has been completely moved to online mode. The 11th admission procedure follows merit base, entering colleges into the streams of science/arts/commerce. If a student has not received his name on the first merit list, he/she should not lose hope and wait for the 11th admission second list 2020. The registration process is carried out in two parts. Part 1 for registration begins on August 1, the date for the 2nd part of the registration will expire soon. Once the fee has been paid, your application will be filled in. First merit list for the general category was issued on August 30, 2020, although the 11th admission process will take place online this year, there are several streams that will not be available in the online admissions procedure. They are: Home Science, HSC Vocational (MCVC), Technical Junior Colleges (TJC)– Admission is carried out by the relevant TJC colleges. Access to the Internal Quota, Management Quota and Minority Quota is also made through the relevant junior college. Entrance to night colleges. Students can change their selected flows while filling out the second form, i.e. the form of registration in Part 2. Before completing the registration forms, students must make sure they meet the eligibility criteria of FYJC 2020. The full eligibility criteria for admission to the FSC by 2020 should be met. Students must take their 10th or SSC or equivalent msbshse exam or any recognized English-language board as the main topic. For admission to bphocal subjects, students must have passed the qualification with General Mathematics as the main topic. Students require a minimum of 35% for admission into the flow of science. Those domiciled in Maharashtra acquire constitutional reservations in the 11th acceptance procedure. Students belonging to other countries and who have passed 10th by the CBSE or other board will need to fill out the form in Appendix A. The total number of colleges in mumbai metropolitan region this year is 849. Pune, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amaravati, Nagpur, will all carry out the process of taking FYJC online. There will be two new quotas this year. A 10 % quota will be allocated to the less economically weaker sections and 16 % to Marathas. The application process started on 1 August 2020 and 1 93 000 applications were submitted on the first day. With the application of the new quotas, 83% to 93% of colleges will be maintained. 2 82 000 brochures related to the reception process have been allocated. There are 39 guidance centers in the region, and admissions officers have asked students not to go to cyber cafes to fill out their forms, and they must adhere to schools and guidance centers to complete the process. Through FYJC, students can take in any of the four streams; HSVC, Science, Commerce and the Arts. To access a junior college by admitting FYJC, students must pass the SSC exam conducted by the Maharashtra Board. Admission is based on the qualities of the student in the qualification exam. Only students who meet the necessary FYJC eligibility criteria will be granted access. The full eligibility criterion to be met for admission by 2020 is given below. The applicant must have passed an SSC or equivalent level examination by the Maharashtra board or other recognised board. The applicant must have completed the English-language qualification as the main subject. In order to gain access to two-focal subjects, the applicant must have chosen general mathematics as one of the subjects for qualification. The applicant must have acquired at least 35 % in Class 10 for admission to the flow of science. Students residing in Maharashtra will be provided with a constitutional admission reservation. Students who are not from Maharashtra or who have passed Class 10 of the CBSE or other board, other than Maharashtra, you must fill out the form of Appendix A.
